At Christmas time our senses become saturated with stimuli - lovely visuals, beautiful music, delightful textures, fragrant holiday scents, and delicious food. In our time of preparation (Advent) we celebrate and honor that God, who came from heaven and earth, knows what it is like to experience the world as we do. God, by sending Jesus, has human senses - eyes to see suffering, ears to hear lament, knowing the saltiness of tears and the desire for compassionate touch. 
