I'm sure you've had an interaction like this before:

Friend: Hi! How are you?

You: Oh, I'm fine. How are you?

[What you're feeling] I'm overwhelmed by life and I'm worried about this thing or that. I've got a to do list a mile long and don't have time to go into it with you.

Friend: I'm fine.

[What your friend is (probably) feeling]: I'm overwhelmed by life and I'm worried about this thing or that. I've got a to do list a mile long and don't have time to go into it with you.

Maybe instead of "Fine," you say something like "Blessed."

During worship on Sept. 4, Pastor Jason shared that he started responding with "blessed" because he was sick of lying when someone asked how he was doing while he was struggling with things at his business.

And, eventually that felt disingenuous too, so he started to say "Blessed and stressed," which recently evolved into our sermon series title: Blessed, stressed, and Trusting God for the rest."

This series isn't about spilling our guts to casual friends when we are feeling "all the things." Instead, It's about opening up to our friends and family when we're struggling. It's about not facing the challenges of our lives alone, and how by sharing how we're really feeling can allow others to walk with us, grow with us, and learn from us.

During this series, we'll be hearing from members of our congregation who've faced - or are facing - struggles. They'll also share how they've balanced those difficulties with blessings and how they've trusted God in the midst of it all.

We hope you'll join us on Sundays at 9:30a to hear from our guest speakers or at 11a to hear from Jason and I about these stories.

May you know God's blessings and presence in the midst of your struggles both in this season and always.


