You know that is how it is sometimes in life. Matthew 14:24; 28-33 talks about how the disciples were in the boat being battered by the wind and as Peter was walking on that water toward Jesus, he became afraid, but Jesus was there to catch him.

24 and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. 28 "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." 29 "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" 31 Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" 32 And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. 33 Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

When the wind and the waves start to rock our boat, we can become afraid, but knowing we have a captain at the helm that is more experienced than we can ever be can make a huge difference in dealing with the storms of life.


I want to encourage you as we start the new year together and the storms come, (which they will) to reach out for Jesus. Let him catch you and let him control the boat.


